

DAILY PROGRAM

PLAY TYPE	TIME	ACTIVITY
Indoor Play	7.30am	Centre opens. Children engage in self-selected indoor activities.
Morning Tea	9.00am	During morning tea time the children are able to select from a wide variety of fruit. This is done progressively so that the children have time to finish activities. Children are encouraged to have some fruit, milk and or water.
Outdoor Play	9.30am	Outdoor experiences are set up for children to self-select These include sand, water play, climbing equipment, construction, dramatic play and arts and crafts. On warm weather days the children can go outside at 9.00am and also enjoy morning tea outdoors. Winter season the children will stay indoors longer until weather warms up.
Indoor Learning	10.50am	Planned small/large group activities. Table top activities that children self-select to expand interests, strengths and individual needs. Children organise their linen for their beds and are encouraged to make them with the help of their educators.
Lunch Time	11.45am G 12.00pm J	Children are encouraged to set up the tables for lunch. This includes placing table cloths on the table, flower vases, pouring drinks and handing out lunchboxes. This is an important social time for both the children and their educators especially concentrating on self help skills.
Prepare for Rest	12.45pm	Children prepare for rest time. Children are encouraged to pack away their lunches, wipe tables down and help sweep the floor (older children). Children proceed with toileting. Children read books on their beds until rest time.
Rest Time	1.00pm	Rest time. 1.45 pm quiet stories, quiet table experiences.
Packing Away	2.30pm	The children help pack away their beds and equipment. They use self-help skills to put on socks and shoes.
Circle Time	2.45pm	Circle Time includes, drama, stories, music and movement, dancing and news.
Outdoor Free Play and Afternoon Tea	3.00pm	Afternoon tea is also in the progressive style. Children are encouraged to partake in afternoon tea as well as having milk and or water. Outdoor free play children can self-select activities and or experiences. Afterwards the children assist in packing away outdoor equipment.
Indoor Free Play	4.30pm	Children engage in self-selected indoor experiences as well as help to set up the environment for the following day.
End of School Day	5.30pm	The centre closes at 5.30pm. Please ensure that you arrive on time as there is a late fee for collection of children after 5.30pm.
